APPLICATION FOR WORKS TO TREES IN A CONSERVATION AREA

- 2172/24/TCA T1: Weeping Willow - reduce overall crown by 3-3.5m to large unions, risk of limb failure, overhangs a public car park, reducing weight from leggy limbs will mitigate future issues for 3-5 years. T2: Goat Willow stool - coppice to 0.5m, risk of failure. Church House Inn, Stokenham – Response 31st July.
