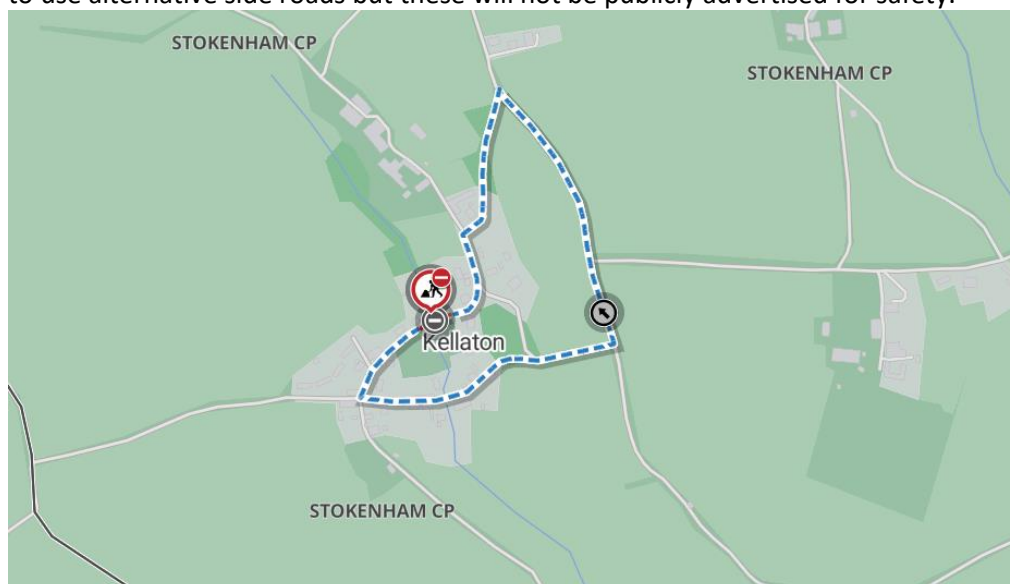
This letter is to give you some information about the forthcoming drainage improvements in Kellaton.
